For the last few Wednesdays this group of enthusiasts has been meeting to watch films of the sport and to do some tale-swapping mixed with a little bench-racing.

- how the proper choice of words can make your speech and writing more effective and persuasive
- how to design your own personal programme of vocabulary building

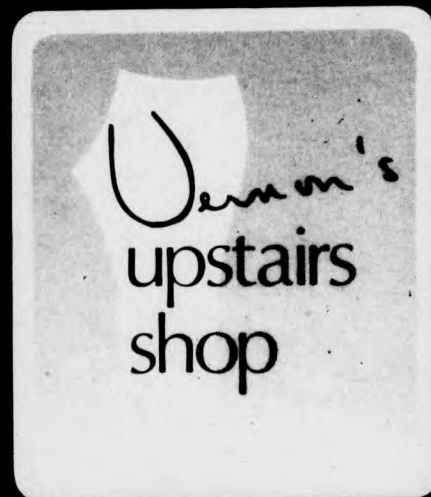
