It is now practically six months since we first wrote you in this matter. And while you have written us that the subject was being given consideration at the first of November last we have not been advised as to whether any decision has been reached. As soon as the snow is off the ground our cattle will be grazing on the land adjoining and if the Indians' plot is not fenced will go right to the main read.

We would like to be advised as to the Department's proposals so that we may not have any hitch in the early spring. In the autumn we had to keep our cattle away from this ground altogether and it will not be convenient to do that in the spring.
