
I beg to forward you herewith three plans on tracing cloth showing Indian Reserves Nos. 155, 155A, and 155 B, which have been allotted and surveyed for certain Indians of Treaty No. 8 and in accordance with the provisions of the said Treaty.

Please note that a Hudson Bay claim having an area of 19.40 acres in the Utikookak Indian Reserve No. 155 is not included in the said Reserve.

The said reserves are too distant from any Dominion lands surveys in the district to warrant our surveyor running connecting lines.

I shall be obliged if the necessary action is taken to have these reserves confirmed by Order in Council, at an early date.
