He was told that such a condition of afflers will not be allowed to exist, and that the Department had written Mr Verrenz and instructed him to make his deductions from Mr Rase's)beef rations in installments each month until the ever-draft is made good. I enclose for your information copy of Mr Rase's reply which is dated the 19th Petrosary.

The Department also found it necessary to draw Mr Race's attention to the report that his stock records at the massacen Agency were not proporty kept. A copy of the letter to him in the matter is transmitted heresitheales copy of his reply which is dated the let instant (Pyle No 180020/10).

The Department desires that you will look into this matter, and also that you will get Mr Verroom to reply to the charges which Mr Race has made .
