Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 28th November and previous correspondence, I beg to say that the Department has decided to appoint Mr. Philippe Dupuis as Constable at Esquimanx Point during part of the year. viz:- about the let May to the end of August. He is to be employed particularly in regard to the suppression or the liquor traffic amongst Indiene. His remuneration will be at the rate of \$50.00 per month. You should advice him of his appointment, and also inform the Department of the date when he takes up his work, and you should submit vouchers monthly, duly certified, for the selary due him.

As indicated in letter of the 7th October the Constable will be allowed moieties of liquor fines as provided for under Liquor clauses of the Indian Act.

A copy of the Indian Act is transmitted herewith for Mr. Dupuie. A badge is being sent by registered mail for the Constable. Your obedient servent.
