


OTTAWA, 27th December, 1922-

Gentlemen-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 16th Instant, enclosing assignments of Lease No 45, covering land on the Semiahmoo Indian Reserve, from Bank of Montreal to Campbell River Lumber Company Limited and from that Company to Campbell River Mills Limited, together with Cheque for \$5.00 to cover fees in connection therewith, and in reply would say that the said assignments have been accepted and the lease now stands in the name of Campbell River Mills Limited.
