In terms of man-power, in the last Wer Canada recruited into the C.E.F., by the voluntary system and conscription combined, 619,000 men in 4 1/2 years of war. She utilized 275,000 in war industry. Total - 894,000.

In a little more than two years of the present War, we have taken into the active strength of the armed forces 344,000 men; in addition, 15,000 trainees have been retained on full-time duty for the duration of the War, and the number of men continuously in training under the Mobilisation Act is 3,000. The number of men on full-time defence today, therefore, is 362,000.
