The accused, sworn, states:-

On June 14, 1943, I was condemned to 18 months military detn. I served 8 months and went out on special release on 18 Feb 44. I went into France at the end of Jul and went AWL. I was arrested in Paris and sent back to the Regt de Mais in Holland and from there to Headley Detn Bks in England to serve the rest of my sentence without being tried.

QUESTIONS BY THE COURT

Q. What kind of release was it?
A. Suspended sentence, Sir.

Q. The charge of AWL from Aug to Oct 44 to which you have now pleaded guilty occurred in France?
A. Yes, Sir.

Q. Were you charged with this before?
A. I was up before Major, I forget his name, of Le Regt de Mais, in Holland on charge for this absence and he said there would be a summary of evidence and he sent me to Headley.

Q. Why did you go AWL?
A. I know it was foolish but I did it. We were in rest at Rompagny before Falaise and I went AWL without any excuse.

Q. Have you been in arrest ever since 5 Oct?
A. Yes, Sir, I was picked up in Paris on 5 Oct and I have been in arrest ever since.

Q. Are you married?
A. No, Sir.
