

After drawing from each copy in the book, let the pupils make drawing from similar objects at hand, or from objects they may see at home—in the latter case they may be drawn from memory after being carefully observed. For instance, ask them to observe and draw a book, a box, or a table, shewing top, or plan, with side and end views. Each pupil should bring some small object and draw the views required to represent it, connecting the views by dotted lines as in the examples given.

Side and end views of a tool chest, strengthened by iron clamps, are given to be copied below, enlarged as indicated. See that the height is in proportion to the width.
