

gularly by his Agent, or else to have paid one year's contribution in advance, and that during every twelve months after that period, if he remits his dues in the course of the year, he will be continued a member of this Society, otherwise he must be excluded; however, during his absence from the Province he cannot be entitled to any benefits, but his widow or children shall receive the sum allowed for funeral expences or legacy, as mentioned in Rule Xth, upon their sending to the President proper vouchers authenticated by two Magistrates or the Minister, and Vestry of the place of residence of the deceased member.—N. B. Members residing out of the Province are only to pay Thirty Shillings per annum.
