The membership of the Board at the close of the present year is 861 members, made up as follows:—681 resident members, and 180 non-resident members. Of these 93 are life members. 32 members have been elected during the year, 13 of whom qualified by transfer to themselves of outstanding certificates, and 19 joined under the new Regulations of the Board as adopted at the General Meeting held on the 30th of June, 1896.
