### IN THE FULL SWING OF MODERN HAY MAKING

The hay loader is not universally popular yet it has come into use on a great many farms in recent years and the fact of its utility has been established. It works best in conjunction with its companion machine—the side delivery rake. With these two implements to assist in haying, the work of putting in the hay crop may be so arranged that just what can be handled will be cut each day. Such practice will never find one caught with a ten-acre block of hay all ready to haul at once, and an old-time soaker of a rain working great damage upon it.
