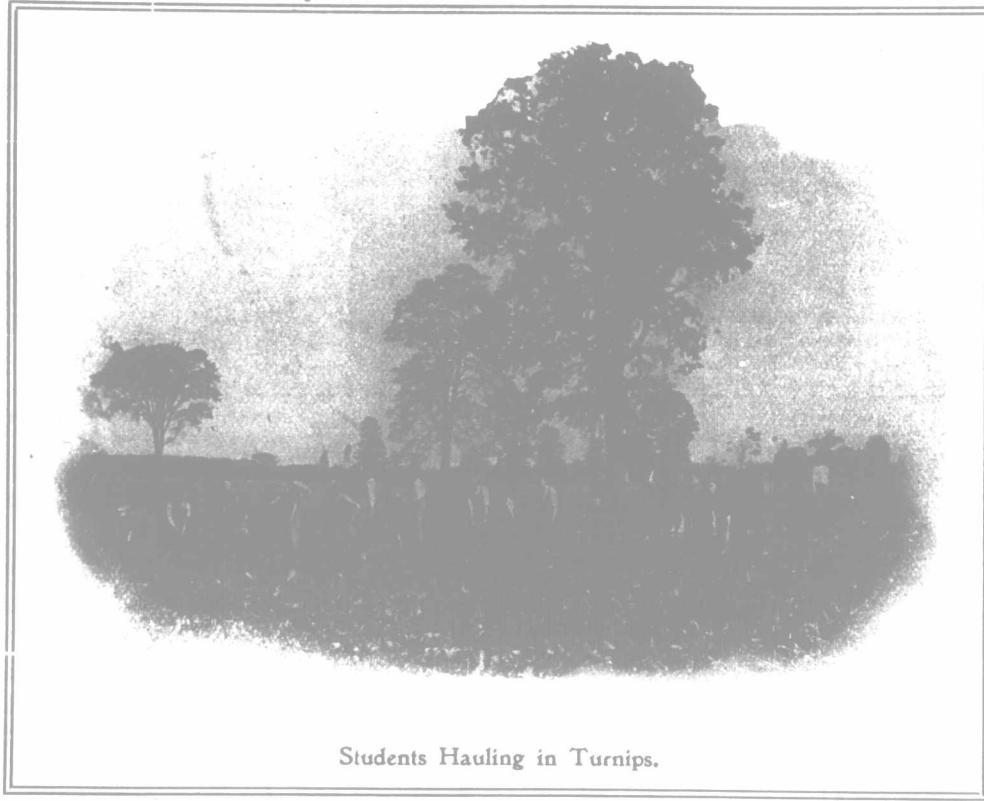


Students Surveying Fields for Drainage.

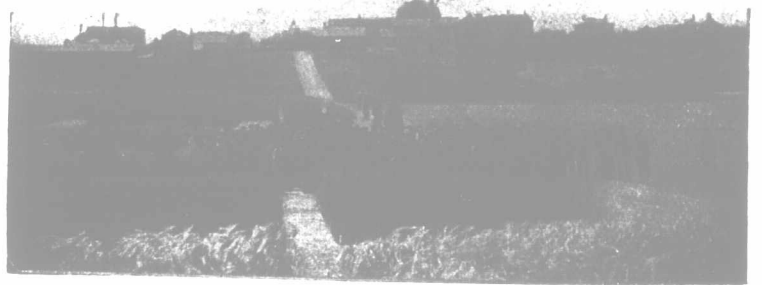
Students Hauling in Turnips.

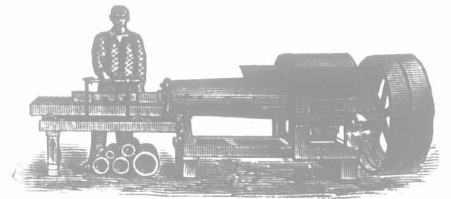
