It appears by this Supervisor's Report, that the distance of road made by him, was about thirteen miles, and chiefly through a perfect wilderness; in which distance there were eight Bridges, averaging about ninety feet in length, one of which by actual contract cost £140 : and it also appears by his Report, that the road has been cut, stumped and turnpiked, with the exception of a very small part thereof. Your Committee are therefore of opinion that this account is satisfactory.

Mr. Doak's account for the year 1827, was audited by the Standing Committee of last Session; and upon a reference to the report of that Committee, your Committee find that the balance brought by Mr. Doak as the first charge in his account was £117 : 2 : 1½, being the balance due to him after deducting the Commission charged by him, as paid to Mr. Taylor. The balance reported to be then due to him was £127 : 6 : 1, with which he commences his account for 1828.
