Death of Rev. Lorenzo White.

LONDON, Jan. 11.—Rev. Lorenzo White, a well-known English Congregational minister, died suddenly yesterday.

Eight Hours a Day.

BIERINGHAM, Eng., Jan. 11.—The Miners' Federation has adopted a resolution asking Parliament to pass a bill making eight hours a legal day's work.

To Be Extradited.

HAVRE, Jan. 11.—The French authorities have decided to surrender Wells, the swindler, to the English Government.

Wells is known as the biggest swindler living.

Death's Doings in Hamburg.

HAMBURG, Jan. 11.—The health officer reports that there were 10,919 deaths from all causes here in 1892, and 26,323 deaths from all causes. The births numbered 22,993.

Coming Cardinals.

ROME, Jan. 11.—The Pope gave an audience to-day to Archbishop Vaughan, of Westminster, and Archbishop Logue, of Armagh, the two prelates who are, it is said, shortly to be promoted to be cardinals.

Killed by Foul Air in a War Vessel.

LONDON, Jan. 11.—While a number of men were engaged in cleaning the bottom of the cruiser Maden at Chatham to-day, four of them were overcome by foul air. Two of them died before medical assistance could reach them.

Ten Helpless Steamships.

HAMBURG, Jan. 11.—Ten steamships were sighted off Copenhagen to-day as they drifted eastward in the midst of enormous ice floes. All had steam up, but were apparently helpless. Only the German tank steamship Paula, Captain Hinch, was recognized.

Attacked by Cholera.

HAMBURG, Jan. 11.—Three more members of the crew of the steamer Murelino, from New Orleans, have been attacked by cholera. Cholera has also appeared among the crews of the ships Laborer and New-comer at Hamburg.

Amsterdam, Jan. 11.—A visitor to this city from Utrecht died the other day of cholera.

He Heeded the Warning.

TANGIER, Jan. 11.—The Sultan has paid quick attention to the ultimatum sent him a few days ago by the British Government, demanding the arrest and punishment of the Moors who some time ago killed a British subject. The three men who are accused of the crime were imprisoned to-day, and upon conviction their punishment will be speedy.

Possible Substitute for the Home Rule Bill.

LONDON, Jan. 12.—"The Morning" says that its French correspondent, who is an intimate friend of the Prime Minister, is strongly of the opinion that Mr. Gladstone intends to "dish" Mr. Lauchlin Currie and upset the Unionists by repealing the act forbidding the Irish Parliament to meet in Dublin instead of presenting the Home Rule Bill. All that would be required, says the correspondent, would be the adoption of a motion by the Privy Council permitting him to pass local acts, leaving bills relating to property and taxation to be debated at Westminster.

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PARIS, Jan. 11.—There is a strong feeling in the Chamber of Deputies, as well as among the general public, that M. Ribot has not yet sufficiently purged the Ministry of those who, whether innocent or guilty, have been under suspicion in connection with the Panama scandal. The public demand is strongly for a thorough investigation without any hampering influence and for a Ministry free from breath of scandal. If M. Ribot should fail to explain to the satisfaction of the Chamber the reasons for the changes which have been made in the Ministry, the Royalists will interpret him on the subject. The leaders of the Royalist party in the Chamber of Deputies came to this decision last evening.

The Royalists have shown greatly increased activity within the past 24 hours, and the authorities appear to be in possession of some new and important information as to their designs. The French Legion in Spain is keeping a most careful watch for intrigues beyond the Pyrenees, and an equally careful watch is being kept on the Royalist plotters in Paris.

The moderate Republican organs accept the new Ministry with good will, while the Radicals are dissatisfied and urge an appeal to the country. The Monarchists assert that the new Cabinet is powerless to dominate the situation. With Bureau removed from the Cabinet it is believed there will be no difficulty in the new Ministry securing the support of the Chamber.

The trial of Charles De Lesseps, Marquis Fontaine, Baron Cottu and M. Eiffel was continued to-day. M.
