

BRAZILIAN TAKES DECIDED SLUMP

Smelters Also Yields on Profit-Taking On the Toronto

Canadian Press Despatch.
Toronto, Jan. 11.—There was a decided falling off in the volume of trading in Brazilian and Smelters during this morning's session of the Toronto stock exchange. The prices were generally lower. Selling described as being of London origin, together with a fall in the milbels, carried Brazilian down to 48 1/2, exacting at last night, while the Smelters yielded 13 1/2. The market taken gain selling induced by denial that increased dividends were contemplated in the near future. The rest of the list was extremely dull, with generally lower prices prevailing. Telephone lost 1 at 129. Toronto Railway was off 1 point at 8 1/2. Twin City and
