Powers Notified That Interests in Persian Gulf Means War.

Protection of Sea Route to India Necessitates England's Predominance.

London, May 6.—Foreign Secretary Lansdowne has proclaimed a British mono doctrine in the Persian Gulf, and has practically notified the competing powers that any attempt on their part to establish a naval base or fortified post in those waters means war with Great Britain.
