## THE LATE DUKE OF THE GREAT AMERICAN SPEED.

General Sir in England would revolutionize the Carriage Building Business—A Warm Tribute to the Harass Performance—A Goshawk Author—The Winner—Racing—Champion—Stake Began in the City.

The late Duke of Marlborough took the greatest interest in the development of the American trotter, and shortly before his death wrote an article on the subject which the cable says was published this week in The London Live Stock Journal. He says: "The general use of trotters in England would revolutionize the carriage building business. It would become necessary to build carriages after the American model, a class of vehicles unrivaled for strength, lightness and ease of manufacture. Englishmen would soon learn to appreciate the four-wheel wagon."
