Mr. Gladstone's Responsibility. The bursting point was soon reached. From the moment Mr. Gladstone decided to employ the gag and the galleries as instruments of Parliamentary oppression, it has been but a question of time, and of circumstances, when the long repressed forces of tyranny on one side and indignation, on the other, should break loose.

The explosion on Thursday was, in truth, but the climax of a long and bitter struggle. With it vanished forever the prestige of dignity and honor, which has belonged to the British House of Commons for more than 600 years. There has been disorder before, but its source was always Irish, and there was always a united force of English opinion, which prevented more disorder from degenerating into violence.

What of the Future? In the future anything may happen. What does it signify which the Irishmen first struck the other? What signifies it that blows have been exchanged and that the oldest great legislative assembly in the world has been the scene of a tavern brawl?

An attempt has been made to trace the origin of this riot to Mr. Chamberlain. The more unscrupulous of his opponents tell you he confessed and begged that he meant to create a disturbance. There is the best authority for saying that this is entirely true. They accuse him of blowing Mr. Gladstone to Heaven. There is no foundation for this either.
