

No. 1. AFTERNOON CONCERT DEESS.



Dark ottoman brocatelle and white lace. The skirt is of lace founces, and the brocatelle Princesse dress has a large lace jabot, and rithou such of the two shades in the brocatelle. Bodice, 2s. 7d.; or dress, fs. 'd.



Ottoman silk, ornamented with wheels, braided in either the same colour or in gold, and silver intermingled. Velvet collarette. Pattern, 1s. 2d.



No. 4. THE FICHU WAISTCOAT. Lace fichu, with lace waistcoot. A bow of ribbon at the right side of the collar. Pattern, is, id.



No. 6. GREY BATIN DRESS. The tablier is box-plaited. The back is formed with bouillonne plaits, and ruched heavily at the edge. The basque is ruched. Cqstume, 8s. Ul.



Figured foulard, with a tilled ground and olive green sprigs. Shaped lines of velvet divide the bouillonnés of plain satin that outline the overskirt. Dress, 3s. 7d.



No. 7. DINNER DRESS. (Back.) The skirt is of white lace. The Princesse overdress is of brocatelle in two shades of any fashionable colour. It is draped high at the back. For front see No. 5. Bodice, 2s. 7d.; dress, 5s. 1d.
