You are specially well placed to reach the many ordinary citizens whose instinct of goodness tells them that the present system does not serve their own countries well and who are searching for new values and concepts of a just global society. And you can reach the youth and sustain them in their rejection of the invalidity of contemporary human relationships and the economic structures directed to perpetuate them; and to channel their energies to the construction of a new order.

Now, more than ever before, the Commonwealth needs to bring to a troubled, frustrated and even more divided world that 'touch of healing' which is its most precious gift to give.
