INTERNATIONAL NEGOTIATIONS AND AGREEMENTS

The following acts of the International Civil Aviation Confer-
ence held at Chicago from November 1st to December 7th, 1944, have
been signed by Canada:

Final Act,
Interim Agreement on International Civil Aviation,
Convention on International Civil Aviation (signed subject
to ratification),
International Air Services Transit Agreement.

Convention modifying the International Sanitary Convention
signed at Paris on June 21, 1926, open for signature at Washington
December 15, 1944, and signed for Canada on January 18, 1945,
subject to ratification.

Convention modifying the International Sanitary Convention for
Aerial Navigation signed at The Hague on April 18, 1933, open for
signature at Washington on December 15, 1944, and signed for Canada
January 18, 1945, subject to ratification.

Exchange of Notes between Canada and the United States concern-
ing the post-war disposition of United States defence projects in
Washington November 28, December 20, 1944.

Exchange of Notes between Canada and the United States concern-
ing an agreement concerning the acquisition of land for United
States defence projects in Canada, Ottawa, December 28, 1944.

Statement by the President of the United States and the
Prime Minister of the United Kingdom and Canada on the decision
of the Combined Chiefs of Staff to postpone the end of Japanese war -
press release of January 19, 1945.
