VISIT TO CANADA BY COMMONWEALTH SECRETARY-GENERAL CHIEF EMEKA ANYAOKU

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Barbara McDougall, today announced that Commonwealth Secretary-General Chief Emeka Anyaoku is making a working visit to Canada, June 25-27, 1991.

Chief Anyaoku will call on Prime Minister Mulroney to discuss the upcoming Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting to be held in Zimbabwe from October 16 to 22, 1991. The Secretary-General will also meet with Minister McDougall in Toronto to review a range of Commonwealth issues.

This is Secretary-General Anyaoku's second visit to Canada as Commonwealth Secretary-General, a position which he assumed in July 1990. His previous visit took place in October 1990.
