

JAMES ARCHIBALD MACAULAY, Q.C.

James A. Macaulay was born on December 30, 1928. He was educated at St. Patrick's College, Ottawa, and Dalhousie University in Halifax, Nova Scotia, and obtained his law degree from the University of British Columbia. He was called to the British Columbia bar in 1957. He practises law with the firm Macaulay and McColl in Vancouver.

Mr. Macaulay was a Lieutenant in the Princess Patricia Canadian Light Infantry from 1950 to 1952, serving in the Second Battalion in Korea, in 1951.
