there, the Russian who is stuck with a communist government, is somehow different from you, that you must shoot at him simply because he is a Russian. And the other fellow, like Brezhnev, who is at the other end and tells his Russians: "You are going to shoot at Canadians because Canadians are capitalists." They are the ones who are truly responsible for wars, not the arms. What is lacking is the leadership, the fact that 300 million Russians are told: "You are communists, you are going to invade Afghanistan. You are communists, your enemies are the Americans." It is the fact that on the other side Americans are told: "Beware, if there is a Russian here, shoot him."

When you play around with people's feelings, you become fascists, fanatics about ideas, flags and states. True peace is there, Mr. Speaker, when people can rise, travel around the globe, without shouting that they want no more nuclear arms because on that day nuclear arms will no longer be needed. But let us start from the inside, let us stop misleading Canadians into believing—
