but has begun to lose some of that buoyancy. Consequently, we are beginning to see this 15 per cent tax cut into margins, cut into reinvestment hopes and therefore ultimately cut into jobs.

We must conclude that it has been a disaster but one that I hope will never be repeated in this country. I hope it will lead Canadians to draw the conclusion that the Government's trade policy is fundamentally bankrupt and unacceptable to Canadians who believe in Canada, and fundamentally unacceptable to those who care about full employment in the future.
