

**REPORT OF THE CORRESPONDING COMMITTEE OF THE
DOMESTIC AND FOREIGN MISSIONARY SOCIETY
OF THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND IN CANADA FOR
THE YEAR ENDING 31ST JULY, 1891.**

The amounts contributed during the year are:—Domestic, \$1,619.96, and Foreign, \$1,706.37, making a total of \$3,326.33. Compared with the previous year, this shows a falling off of \$594.75.

It will be seen that the main decrease is in the amount for Foreign Missions, and this is owing to the fact that the subscriptions in the last few years have been increased from sources that cannot be expected to be permanent. In Domestic Missions there is, under the head of General Purposes, a falling off of \$180.76, and also of \$29.00 in the sum contributed to the Diocese of Qu'Appelle; but on the other hand there is an increase in the amounts given to each of the other N. W. Dioceses, so that when all are considered the net decrease is \$78.65. The particulars are given in the following table:—
