GREAT NORTHERN ENJOINED

St. Paul, Minn., Jan. 23.—By order of the county court, the Great Northern Railway was to-day enjoined temporarily, pending the court's decision, from issuing its proposed \$60,000,000 worth of additional stock, without first obtaining approval of the state railroad commission.

As Judge Haliam's order states that the company's contentions cannot be sustained, and that application must be made to the commission before issuing the proposed stock, the decision, so far as the county court is concerned, is final.

Judge Haliam, in a memorandum, says that the state concedes that, under the general laws of the state, the defendant may lawfully increase its stock, subject to the regulation mentioned. The court says the injunction was asked for to compel the company to submit to this regulation, which the defendant does not propose to do. Therefore the court holds that there is but one issue raised in the case, and the ultimate right of the railroad company to make the proposed issue of stock is not involved.
