CANNED 'EATS' BARRED
FROM CANADA TABLES

Toronto, Aug. 23.—In view of the
abundance of food obtainable from the
garden and field, Hon. W. J. Hanna,
food controller, has decreed that the
sale and consumption of canned
goods for the present must cease.

He has ordered that an embargo, effective today, shall be placed on canned
peas, corn, tomatoes, etc.

Such goods cannot now be sold by
the retailers nor be consumed in the
household, and only in the case of mining
and construction camps and dining
cars are exceptions allowed to this order.

Live hogs resumed their irascible
advance toward the expected \$19 mark
today, when every porker offered on the
market brought \$18 per cwt. This un-

precedented price is an advance of 75c
over yesterday's quotations, and an in-

crease in hog values over those of two
weeks ago of \$2.15 is confidently an-

tipulated that the \$19 mark will be
reached before the end of the month

and at the rate of the advances of the
last week, the next few days will see

values well over the present prices of
Toronto and Detroit.
