Quite frankly we are having a difficult time trying to keep the timber permit accounts from your Agency in order. Therefore, will you kindly see to it that in future when making out receipts for timber dues you show on the receipt or on your return the species, the number of feet cut and the permit number under which the timber was cut. Where two or more permit numbers are shown on the receipt it is imperative that we know how much of the payment is to be applied on each permit. Your close attention to this matter will be very much appreciated.
