Ladies and Gentlemen:

The writs for the general election to be held on Dec. 17 next, having been issued, and, being the New Brunswick representative in the new union government, in appealing to you for your support I feel it incumbent upon me in as brief a manner as possible to state to you my position, and the reasons for the formation of the government three weeks ago.

The real question before the electors of Canada today is whether or not this dominion will do its full duty, not only to itself, the empire at large, and the civilization of the world, but to the soldiers who have already gone forward, many of whom have made the supreme sacrifice. Tens of thousands of others have been maimed and wounded, and


