SUGGESTIONS FOR USING

SUBSTITUTES FOR AMERICAN ANTHRACITE

IN ORDINARY HOUSE FURNACES

1. No change is necessary in furnace. Build the fire in the usual way. 2. Open all the drafts and leave them open for about ten minutes. This to allow the smoke and gases to pass out of the chimney.

6. After the coal has been burning for about ten minutes or long enough the smoke and gases to have been expelled, close up all the drafts except thimney draft, which should be left partially open.

6. Bituminous coal will probably be in varying sizes and contain some slack. The lumps should be burned in the day time and the fire banked with smaller coal and slack at night, leaving a small opening at the top to let the

When making the last fire at night shake out the fine ash that will be dogging the openings in the grate. Your grates will last far longer if kept

7. By throwing a moderate amount of water upon the Bituminous pile at the point from which the coal is taken out the dust and dirt objection is largely overcome, as well as reducing the amount of smoke when the coal is first thrown on the fire.

9. With Bituminous Coal more soot is formed in stovepipes, flues and chimneys than in case of Anthracite; and furnaces, furnace pipes and chimneys should be cleaned frequently. Hot water furnaces should be cleaned every day or so, and the furnace pipes every two or three weeks. Soot will not accumulate as quickly if a small quantity of zinc clippings are occasionally thrown into the fire.
