Territory Handed to Canada by Britain in 1880, Says Stewart

TITLE IS TERMED INCONTESTABLE

Navigators Who Visited Region Include Ross Franklin and Others.

OTTAWA, June 12-Hon. Charles Stewart, Minister of the Interior, in a further statement issued tonight emmade for Canadian ownership of North-

ern Archipelago.

"The present policy," he says, "is simply a continuation of methods followed for many years past in administering the northern territories of the Dominion." EXPEDITIONS SENT OUT.

"For years," he adds, "the Canadia "For years," he adds, "the Canadian government has been sending out expeditions and at much expense has established posts at Ellesmere, Devon and other islands."

Mr. Stewart also states that in 1880 Great Britain, by imperial order-incouncil, transferred the Arctic archipel-

council, transferred the Arctic archipelago to Canada.

So far as discovery goes Mr. Stewart says that the title of Great Britain and thus of Canada, to the northern islands, is beyond question. With few exceptions all the known insular areas in the Canadian Arctic were discovered and formally taken possession of by British commissioned navigators from a century to three-quarters of a century ago. A list of English navigators would include Bylot and Baffin, who discovered Ellesmere Island in 1816; Captain John Ross, R.N., Sir John Franklin, Commander Inglefield, R.N., Captain Nares, R.N., and many others.


