PREFFY GIRL

Seventeen Year Old. Miss Fires Bullet Into Temple During Absence of Her Mother-Cause Unknown

Campobelle, April 27.—The town of Lubec is in mourning as the result of the suicide fo Miss Hattle Daggett, the pretty seventeen year old daughter of Mrs. Hatsel Mahar. Miss Daggett shot herself in the temple with a 38 calibre revolver, death being practically instantaneous. Mrs. Mahar, at whose home her daughter by a former marriage lived, arose early and finished her household work, calling to the girl to ask her if she was going to work in one of the herring shops. She replied that she did not know whether she would or not, and Mrs. Mahar went to work, leaving her at home.

A short time later a shot was heard by one of the neighbors and on investigation the girl was found grasping the revolver which caused her death. The motive for the suicide is not known. She had been a member of the Methodist Sunday school and seemed to be of a happy disposition, although somewhat nervous at times.

The son of the late Henry Corby, founder of the Corby distillery business, Senator Corgy was born in Belleville on May 2, 1851. In his hands the business left to him by his father grew to large dimensions, incorporation as a company taking place in 1905. From that time Mr. Corby gradually dropped his active connection with the business. For several years, commencing in 1878, the Corby Company did business in Dock street, St. John.

A strong Conservative he represented West Hastings in the House of Commons from 1888 to 1991. In 1912 he was appointed to the Senate.
