

- Military defence, by whatever mode of Conveyance the same shall have been so purchased or taken either in fee or any life or lives, or any term or terms of years, or any other or lesser interest, and all erections and buildings which now are or which shall or may hereafter be erected and built thereon, together with the rights, members, easements and appurtenances to the same respectively belonging, shall, by virtue of this Act, be and become and remain and continue absolutely vested in Her Majesty the Queen, for the benefit, use and purposes of this Province, according to the respective nature and quality of the said lands and other real property, and shall be subject to the provisions of the Act passed by the Legislature of this Province, in the sixteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, *An Act to amend the law for the Sale and Settlement of Public Lands*, and any further provisions which the Legislature of Canada may from time to time enact in respect thereof, and shall be held, used, conveyed and dealt with accordingly; but subject nevertheless to all or any Lease or Leases, Agreement or Agreements for Lease already entered into, with or by the Principal Officers of Ordnance, or any person or persons authorized or empowered by the said Principal Officers to exercise the powers and authorities of the said in part recited Act of the seventh year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, of or in respect of any such lands and other real property.
- 25 VII. With respect to all lands and other real property comprised in the second Schedule to this Act annexed, which by this Act shall be vested in Her Majesty the Queen for the benefit, use and purposes of this Province, the said recited Act of the seventh year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, and every clause, matter and thing therein contained, shall, from and immediately after the passing of this Act, be repealed, and the same is and are hereby repealed accordingly.

- Act 7 V. c. 11 not to apply to lands, &c., transferred to the Province.

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

REFERRED to in this Act, being the Schedule of Military Lands in Canada, to be vested in one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State.

QUEBEC.

The Citadel of Quebec, Fortifications, Glaciers, Barracks, Lands with the appurtenances thereunto in any manner belonging, and the Barracks called the Jesuit Barracks, and the several Public Offices occupied for the various Military purposes, and all other Military properties at that station.
