An Act to amend an Act relating to Masters and Servants in the country parts of Lower Canada.

THEREAS it is expedient to repeal the Preamble. Act hereinafter mentioned, and to make better provision for the decision of differences arising in the country parts of Lower 5 Canada, between Masters and Mistresses, and

their Apprentices, Servants, Journeymen or Labourers: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Act of the Legislature of Act of L. C. 10 Lower Canada, passed in the sixth year of repealed.

- the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, and intituled, "An Act for the more easy and less expensive decision of differences between Masters and Mistresses and 15 their Servants, Apprentices and Labourers, in
- the country parts of this Province," shall be and is hereby repealed.

II. And be it enacted, That this Act shall Towhatplaces apply to those parts of Lower Canada which this Act shall apply. 20 are not within the cities of Quebec or Montreal, or the town of Three Rivers, and to no other part of this Province.

III. And be it enacted, That any and all Pepalty on Apprentices or Servants of either sex, or beying their 25 Journeymen or Labourers bound by act of Masters, &c. indenture or written contract or agreement, and all Servants of either sex! or Journeymen or Labourers verbally engaged before one or more witnesses for one month or for 30 any longer or shorter period, who shall be guilty of ill behaviour, refractory conduct, or idleness or of deserting from their service or duties, cr of absenting themselves by day A 292
