Editor's Talk

OR two months now we have been experimenting with our woman's department. Formerly we published a page of matter each week, with a Supplement once a month. Recently we tried enlarging this feature of our work by publishing the Supplement twice a month. The results justify us in announcing that the change will be permanent.

From the beginning of the "Canadian Courier," six and a half years ago, we have aimed to make this a "family journal" rather than "a man's paper." We wanted it to go into the home, and to help in the education and entertainment of all members of the family. For this reason, we have not overlooked those features which would interest women, nor even those which would be attractive to children. The Canadian home is unequalled by any other home in the world, and hence the "Canadian Courier" must have a corresponding character.

The question of the best form of civic government for Canada is becoming more pressing. At present, there are all sorts of systems in vogue. Some cities are even trying pure commission government.
