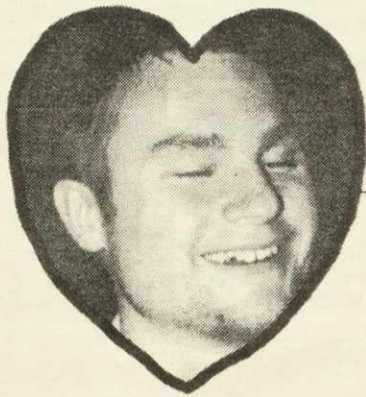


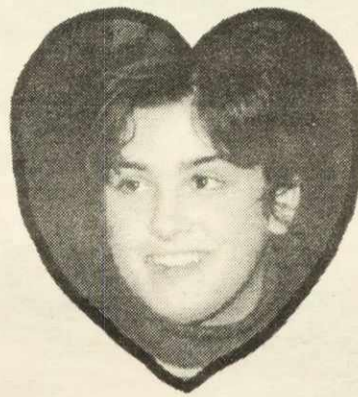
# What's the worst lie you've ever told someone you were dating?

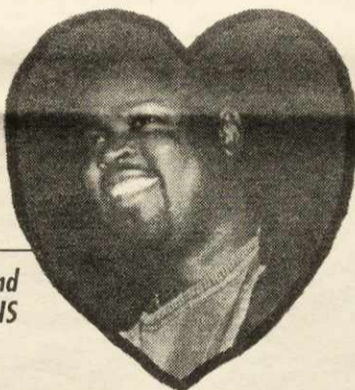

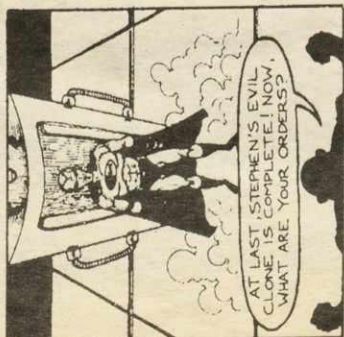

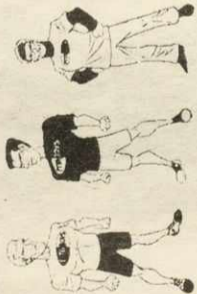
