Herewith is a set of regulations adopted by the Swan Lake band of Indians on the 4th instant, which now require confirmation by the Governor in Council, for the establishment of a pound and the appointment of a pound-keeper on the Swan Lake Indian Reserve.

These are the same regulations as have been put in force on a great many reserves and are such as are provided for under Sub-section (g) of Section 98 of the Indian Act.
