STREETS A BRIDGES

The council may call upon each and every able bodied man of the band to perform three days "statute labor"each, each year upon some public improvement for the village, and may appoint a road mater for carrying out such works, who may call such men as any be necessary; a few men at a time, or all together, so that each man shall do his equal share of public work, or pay an equivalent therefor.
