Five Councillors sitting together shall form a quorum for the transaction of business, and a majority vote shall carry and decide the question before the Council.

BY-LAW NO. 1.

POLICE

The Council may at any meeting appoint three fit and proper persons to be watchmen and village police, and may dismiss any such watchmen and appoint another in his stead.

The village police may be sworn before any Justice of the Peace.

BY-LAW NO. 2

STREETS & BRIDGES

The council may call upon each and every able bodied man of the band to perform three days "statute labor" each, each year upon some public improvement for the village, and may appoint a roadmaster for carrying out such works, who may call such men as may be necessary; a few men at a time, or all together, so that each man shall do his equal share of public work, or pay an equivalent therefor.

But all men over sixty years of age or sick men should not be asked to do this work.
