In reply to your letter of Dec 23  
6079, I beg to say, that though  
portions of the Indian Reserve  
at Fisher's Grant are thickly  
wooded, the said wood cannot  
be used for firewood - for fuel  
as it is of the soft variety, chiefly  
spruce. To keep themselves warm  
during the winter the Indians have  
to steal the firewood, which they have been  
doing much to the chagrin of the  
proprietors. The wood in the reserve  
is valuable for fencing and will be  
useful for that purpose for many
