



Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 3rd Instant, enclosing an application by Samuel Lovely, of Perth, N.B. for the purchase of Lot 7, Block B, Tobique Reserve, and stating that this Lot is unfit for settlement, with no merchantable timber thereon, I have to inform you that you may have this Lot examined under oath, as provided by Sec. 6 of the Regulations.
