I find that by an Order in Council of 17th February. 1888, authority was given for the holding of an election under the Indian Advancement Act on the 25th April. 1888, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., and that the provisions of the said Act were to be applied to the band from the date on which the election was confirmed by the Indian Agent.
