## **EDUCATION DEPARTMENT (Ontario).**

Primary and Junior and Senior Leaving Examinations, 1890.

Candidates for the above examinations should notify the presiding Inspector, not later than the 24th of May, of their intention to present themselves for examination. All notices to the Department for intending Candidates must be sent through the presiding Inspector.

The presiding Inspector will please give sufficient public notice respecting the Examinations

The Head Masters of Collegiate Institutes and High Schools will please send the appli-cations of their Candidates, together with the required fee of Five Dollars from each Candidate, to the Local Public School Inspector, and in case of there being more than one Inspector in a County, to the one with n whose jurisdiction the School is situated. In the case of Candidates for the Senior Leaving Examination, the form of application is to be sent, through the Inspector, to the Local more than the sentence of the senior the sen to the Education Depar ment.

Where the number of Cand dates necessitates the use of more rooms than one, those taking the University examination are, in order to prevent confusion, to be seated in the same room.

Candi tates for the Senior Leaving Examination will be examined at the following places: Guelph, Hamilton, Kingston, London, Ottawa, Toronto; or at such o her place as may be desired by any Board of Trustees on notice to the Department on or before the 25th day of May; it being understood that the Board is willing to bear the expense of conducting the examination.

The Primary and Junior Leaving Examinations will begin on Tuesday the 8th July, at 8.40 a.m.; and the Senior Leaving Examinations on Tuesday, the 15th July, at the same hour.

Candidates for grade A or B will be examined at the University of Toronto (examinations begin 2nd. May).

For the Junior Leaving Examinations Candidates are examined on the Junior Matricula-tion Pass papers of the University of Toronto, and for the Senior Leaving Examination, on the Honor papers.
