BRITISH PARLIAMENT SAT ALL NIGHT.

London, July 15.—The House of Commons sat until five o'clock this morning, when it passed the report of the Irish local government bill.

BRITAIN FOR ARBITRATOR. London, July 15.—The St. James Gazette says it learns from an authoritative source that the British Government has formally consented to arbitrate the boundary dispute between Chili and Argentina, the matter is not mutually settled by Aug. 15.

NO CHANCE FOR WOMEN.

Berlin, July 15.—The movement in favor of the higher education of women in Germany has just received a severe check. At the conference at Wiesbaden of the German Medical Association, numbering about 15,000 members, a motion was adopted against the admission of women to the study of medicine.

LADY SALISBURY'S ILLNESS.

London, July 15.—A critical surgical operation was performed Wednesday morning upon Lady Salisbury, wife of the prime minister. The operation was successful. Six doctors assisted, including Sir William H. Broadbent, physician in ordinary to the Prince of Wales, and Dr. Charles Theodore Williams, physician extraordinary to the Queen. Lady Salisbury has long been afflicted with dropsy. The operation immediately improved the result of the operation.

CABLE NOTES.

A London cable says: The proposed A. London cable says: The proposed volunteer artillerists to compete with the gunners of the Dominion has been put off until next year. The encouragement to the scheme, both from the war office and elsewhere, was of the slenderest description.

The well known Liverpool shipping firm of Messrs. Elder, Dempster & Co., have just insured a portion of their lines for £2,000,000, taking about a fifth of the risk themselves. The rate is 5 per cent, consequently the yearly premium figures out at £150,000.

FATEFUL FLAMES

Five and Possibly Eleven Persons Perish in a Burning Building.

Racine, Wis., July 15.—By the burning of the Racine Malleable and Wrought Iron Company's work at Racine, Wis., on Wednesday, three lives were lost, and eight persons are missing.

The dead are known as: John Keefe, Gus Knefski, an unidentified body, supposed to be Adelbert Hollister. Eight others are missing. Those supposed to be dead among the injured are: Chris Foulson, fatal; Geo. Casey, fatal.

The fire started in the varnish room, and suddenly leaped out into the main shop, and enveloped the whole building, in which were a hundred men. Those on the ground floor had no trouble in escaping, and most of the men on the second floor got out without injury but the workmen on the third floor were caught as in a trap. Many of them appeared in windows crying for help, while others jumped to the street below, receiving fatal or serious injuries. Two hundred men will be thrown out of work. The plant will be rebuilt. Loss, \$100,000.

Forest, Ont., July 15.—Yesterday morning the brick residence of Alcega and Love was destroyed by fire, most of the contents being saved. There was \$500 insurance on the building.

St. Catharines, July 15.—The handsome two-story brick residence of Mrs. Catharine Donoghue, on Welland avenue, was badly damaged by fire yesterday. Total loss about \$50,000. Insurance.

Durham, Ont., July 15.—Fire in Charles Smith's furniture store, has resulted in the destruction of a large stock of clothing patterns, damage to building and machinery, of about \$2,500; insured for \$800.

TURNER DOWNED

The British Columbia Government Defeated—Several Seats Protested.

Winnipeg, July 15.—Numerous private telegrams received here from Vancouver leave little or no room to doubt that the Turner government is defeated.

PROTESTS THERE, TOO. Protests have been lodged to void the election of Dean in North Yale, Ellison in East Yale, and Kelly in Revelstoke. Bribery and corruption in each case are alleged. The opposition is preparing to make a hard fight for Cassiar, where the election is yet to be held. Messrs. Sword and Brown go up as nominees of the straight opposition party, and D. W. Higgins as independent.

ELECTION PROTESTS.

Toronto, July 15.—Mr. Justice MacLennan has been appointed an additional judge on the rota for the trial of provincial election protests.

FORTUNE IN BINDER TWINE.

Detroit, July 15.—Dealers in binder twine, who were fortunate enough to make their purchases of manila twine last year are going to make fortunes on their deals. Twine purchased for 6 cents last year is selling to the farmers today for 12 to 15 cents. G. Woodford, a curet dealer, has netted a profit of \$10 per ton on his sales, which aggregate about 1,000 tons.

WORK AND WAGES

Three Hundred Men Are Out of Two Institutions in Walkerville.

Illinois Labor Union Chooses a Label on Coal.

Windsor, July 15.—The employees of the Malleable Iron Company, and the Kerr Engine Company, E. Walkerville, are out on strike. The trouble started with the molders in the malleable iron works, who demanded a raise of 20 per cent in the prices paid them. Manager Frees, told them that such an increase was altogether out of the question now, but he would do something later on. The men were not satisfied with this, and went out, taking with them the coremakers, laborers and others. There are over 100 of the Engine Company's men out, and 200 of the Iron Company's men.

Springfield, July 15.—It now looks as though the difference between the coal miners and operators throughout Illinois might be decided by arbitration. The operators have been informed that the state board of arbitration that they would agree to arbitration. The miners' executive board chose a union label to be placed on all union mined coal.

JAIL FOR LIFE

Bram, the Mate of the Herbert Fuller. Waives an Appeal.

Boston, Mass., July 15.—Thomas M. Bram, formerly mate of the barkentine Herbert Fuller, and who was accused of the murder of Capt. Chas. I. Nash, Mrs. Nash, and the Second Mate Blomberg, on board the vessel, in July, 1896, and who, after two sensational trials, was found guilty "without capital punishment of the murder of Capt. Nash, was yesterday sentenced to a life term at hard labor in the state prison in Charlestown. Counsel for prisoner, however, an appeal was taken to the court, declaring that he was a victim of circumstances and not guilty of the crime. He said: "I have nothing to say to my lawyers' feet but my thanks for the manner in which they have truthfully laid my case before you. May God bless them and all those that have injured me."

When Bram was seated, Judge Colt pronounced the sentence, and he heard the sentence of the court.

GROSS BLUNDERS

Caused Needless Losses at Santiago.

Chicago, July 14.—The Record has a special from the seat of war in Cuba that it would not have been ordinary. The correspondent for the London Telegraph, who accompanied the army from Tampa to Santiago, was also a passenger on the steamer.

In an interview he corroborated the statements made by Capt. Kerr and the other wounded and soldiers sent back from the field. Mr. Nuttall was at the front, and was in the midst of the battle of El Caney. He said: "There has been gross mismanagement on the part of whoever is responsible for the condition of the American army in Cuba. The people of the United States do not know the extent of their losses. I believe the number estimated in this country as having been killed and wounded will fall far short of the actual number. I do not hesitate to say that 90 per cent of the lives sacrificed and the sufferings of the wounded are attributable to enormous blunders."

"When I first landed most of the soldiers, which was advertised in this country as having played an important part in the fighting at Santiago, were still on the transport, and no one knew where to find any particular part of one. It will doubtless be remembered by the commander of the American army in Cuba when explanations are in order that the reason for not sending the siege guns to the front and covering the infantry was the bad condition of the roads."

"However, eight days intervened before the siege guns were sent to the front, and the beginning of the rain. After the eighth day it rained incessantly, and great ponds formed in places across the roads, and to cross many low places one was compelled to wade knee-deep in mire. Then, of course, the movement of the heavy guns was an impossibility, but during those eight days of splendid weather which succeeded our landing every gun should have been hauled to a position commanding Santiago."

Whether it will be possible to keep the details of the story of construction of these new ships a secret for any length of time after they are built remains to be seen; but as giving attention to their naval armaments are only waiting the first indication to start building similar vessels.

The great question in England now is as to the value of the older armor-plated ships, and it is still being argued on the list of effective ships. Lord Charles Bessford, who has made this subject particularly his own, has conclusively shown that as at present armed they are useless for purposes of modern warfare, and he calls for the complete rearmament of not less than 45 of these ships. The muzzle-loaders, with which they are at present furnished, are of no more use to sea to meet the ships of France, Russia, or Germany would be a criminal act. Of these 45, 37 figure on the last parliamentary return, which shows the armored vessels of the British navy to comprise 64 battleships, 25 armored cruisers and 15 coast defense ships, as against 57 battleships, 30 armored cruisers and 30 coast defense ships which are included in the united French and Russian navies, all armed with the best modern guns.

Hitherto it has been considered that all vessels built since 1890 might be classed as effective, but it is now held to be doubtful whether, through the advance made in the manipulation of high explosives, and in consequence of the power and rapidity of fire of modern guns, those vessels built before 1885 may not also have to be relegated to the list of those classed as obsolete for the battle line. In that case a large number of the French and Russian ships, which are on the effective list also, though they, as well as the British ships similarly placed, could still render effective service in the matter of coast and harbor defense.

But if the ships to be built under the new British programme come up to the expectations formed of them, we may be entering on an entirely new period of naval construction, and we shall place the latest built war vessels where those of ten years back are now. For designers and inventors it will be a highly interesting time, and in the new stimulus to produce the ideal warship we may arrive at something that will place at the disposal of some one country the power of imposing peace on all others. That country will undoubtedly be the one where

THE CITY OF CADIZ

Is a Most Interesting Relic of Antiquity.

Considered the Key to Spain—Her Adventurous Sons—Battles in Caesar Harbor.

The president's rumored intention of carrying the war into Spain has inspired in the United States a great interest in the city of Cadiz. It presents the triple advantage of being practical, popular and picturesque. One does not need to be a prophet to assume that unless there is a general smash-up in the meantime it would also be productive of peace. Cadiz, a city of 100,000 inhabitants, was precisely as it did after the French expedition in 1823. In that instance the siege lasted three months. Previously the city had been in the hands of the Spaniards for a period which exceeded two years. In the last century again and again it was unsuccessfully attacked, and again, nearer and nearer this way. It was a stronghold; it is a very beautiful place. It is famous, too. It is there that the simple quater Caesar wept. At the time it was renowned for the sheen of its purple, for wine smoother than Palernian, for honey more aromatic than that of Hybla, and for girls that had the Orient in their eyes and lips that said "Drink."

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
