eamship "Warrimoo," of the Cana dian-Australian Line, Arrives on Schedule Time.

Encouraging Prospects for Trade and Passengers - Around the World in Sixty Days,

The second of the steamships of the new Canadian-Australian line arrived last night, at 11 o'clock, and tied up at the outer wharf, being immediately granted a clean bill of health, there having been no illness on board during the whole of the delightful voyage from Sydney. This ship—the Warrimoo-is a sister ship of the Miowera, and like he is a commodious, safe vessel, elegantly fitted and arranged for the carrying of passengers. She made the trip in schedule time, arriving here at exactly the same hour of the night as her predecessor.

In connection with this trip, an interest

ing experiment is being tried. The mails which left London on the night of May 19, for Australia, arrived there per steamship Hymalaya on the forenoon of June 17. The Warrimoo sailed the same evening, time being given, at the request of the postmaster general for correspondents to reply to their London letters, the mails will be put on board the Atlantic express of Sunday (to-day) and it is hoped a rapid run across to London will land replies to the letters dated May 19, "Round the world in sixty days!" in sixty days !"
