Superfine is selling at \$5, and choice brands 250 h gher. Corn meal is held at \$4 65 to \$4.76.

Freight mayigation is opening early, there is rather more enquiry for tonnage, but quotations are likely to continue strady. The following deal charters are reported: Steamship Britannia, 1118. Glasgow, 63s 34: Now Era, 1100, and steamship Alhambra, 722, both for Liverpool 69s. Rossio Farker, 639, for Sharpuces, 61s; Abbie Fhomas, 591, Limerick, 70s; Nova, Bantry, 75s; Aitre, 633, Dublin or Bellast, pt.

In West india treights there is very little doing. We hear of the charter of the Irvine, 197, for Cardenas, lumber, \$7.50, gold; A. J. Ross, 198, Cleniuegos, \$8 under and \$7.50 on deck.

For *Clayedoffers are 87s. while operations have all been made on a basis of 8jrs to 8jrs for No. 12 D. 8 in good condition. Derosne's train is capecially solicited, Nos. 10 to 13 being paid for, on a basis of 8jrs for No. 12, and this grade has an upward tendency. High grades for Spain are still taken at fancy prices. Contrifugals have been operated in more freely at fully previous rates, quotations being: Nos. 10 and 12, 7jrs to 8rs. Nos. 12 and 13, 8rs to 8jrs, and Nos. 18 and 15 nominuity ejrs.
