<u>HISTORY</u>	
1854 - 66	U.S. - Canada Reciprocity Treaty
1866	Treaty abrogated by U.S.
1869 - 1923	Canada attempts to reinstate Treaty 7 times
1882	U.S. - Mexico Reciprocity Treaty

- 1965 - U.S. - Canada Auto Pact
- 1979 - Mexico rejects GATT Membership
- 1979 - U.S. assesses "special relationship" with Mexico (PRM51)
- 1982 - Mexico looses "Injury Test"
- 1982 - U.S. - Mexico Agreement on Subsidies & Countervailing Duties
- 1986 - Mexico joins GATT
- 1987 - Framework Agreement on Bilateral Trade (U.S. & Mexico)
- 1989 - Implementation of U.S. - Canada FTA begins
- 1990 - President Salinas proposes a U.S.- Mexico Trade Agreement
- 1991 - NAFTA negotiations begin
- 1992 - Single Market completed in Europe
- 1994 - Implementation of NAFTA begins
