ECLIPSES.

In the year 1850 there will be only two Eclipses ;
both of the Sun.

I.—An Annular Eclipse of the Sun, February 12th,
invisible at Montreal. Conjunction in Right Ascen-
sion at 1 hour 37 minutes in the morning.

II.—A Total Eclipse of the Sun, August 7th, invis-
ible at Montreal. The mean time of Conjunction in
Right Ascension will be at 4 hours and 37 minutes in
the evening. This Eclipse will be seen from the
North and Western parts of South America, from
Mexico, California, Oregon, and from the Japanese
Islands.
